## Pattern

**Frame size:** customizable

**Step1-** Measurements time

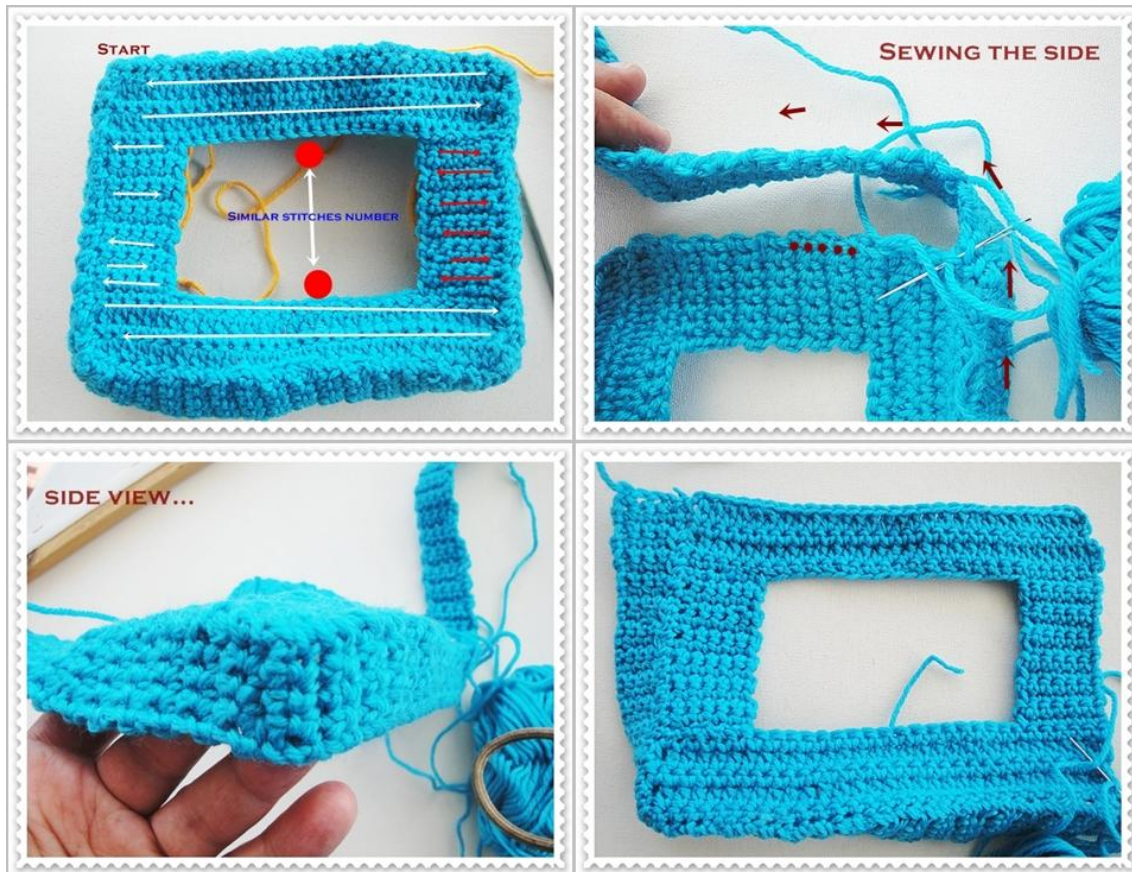
**Places:**

number **1**, **2** and **side** of the frame. Decide the “**Open Space**” you wish for the photo visible zone. You can also start working and check it meanwhile.

**Make a chain as long as measurement 1**







**How to start the work:** The white arrow zone is where we start, just follow the directions.

**Up zone made and one column side...**and you continue the down zone also. Front zone worked **with hdc.**

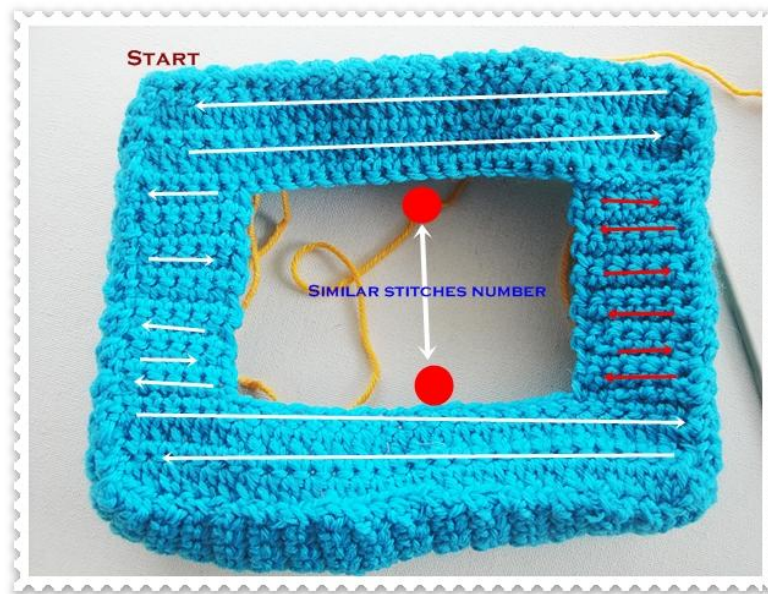
**How?** Lets say the top has a total of 50 stitches. The “total down side” must include those 50 sts. If you already worked 10 stitches on the column just work the missing 40! Make some rows more to finish the down part.

All measurements are simetrical! That means both columns include same number of stitches. Also up and down!

**Red arrow zone:** Is the missing part to build. Cut the yarn, fasten off and start again at the right side column.

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The long ribbon for the side



**This pattern required 6 sts ch to build the side ribbon**

(ch7,sc in second ch from hook, sc each st across, ch1, turn, sc each st across, repeat the pattern)

Maybe yours is *bigger or smaller*. That is not a problem! Adjust.

**Work as long as necessary** to match the front work.

**Next:** sew the ribbon to the main work (front), *st by st* .



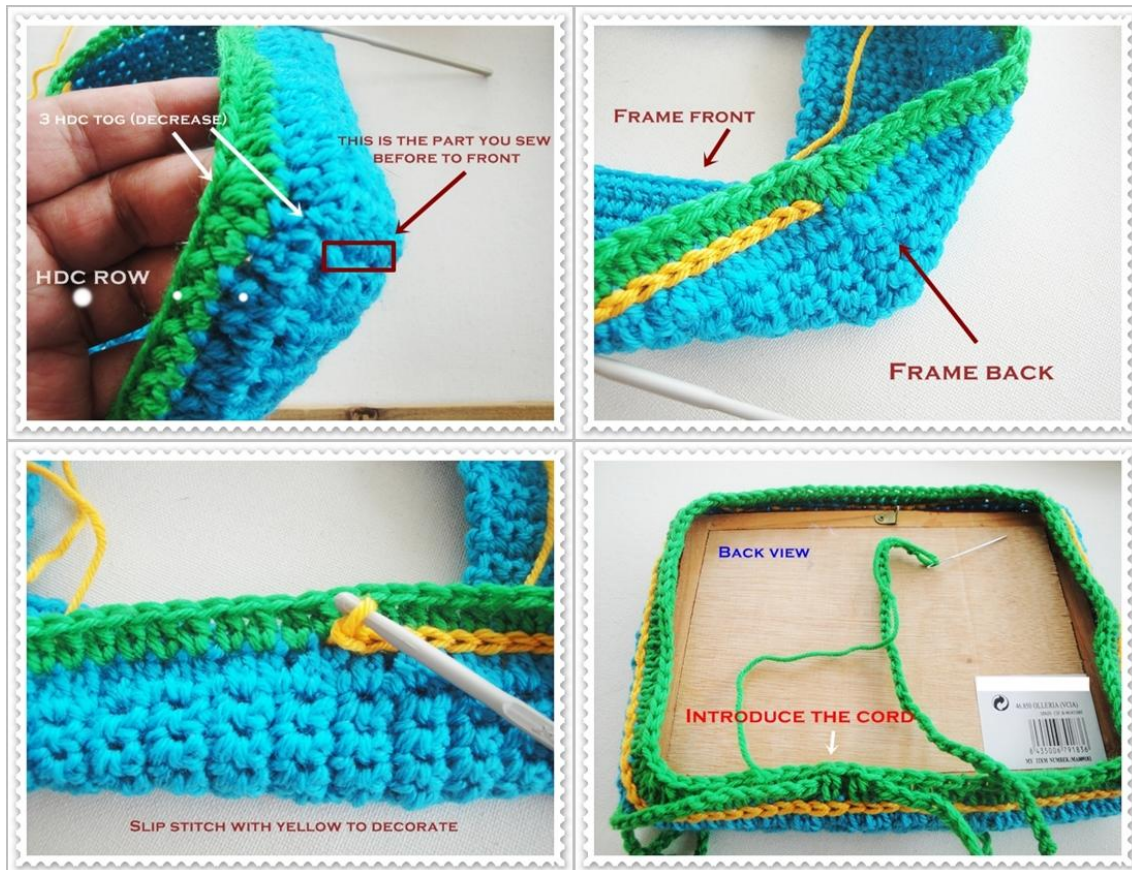
**Continue.** That part is done. Join the yarn again, work two rows of hdc around, with different colors each.

**NOTE:** at the corners work 3 hdc together to decrease. All 4 corners, at the 2 rows.



Slip stitch with yellow, just decoration...





## The Back view:

You see 2 hdc rows, and a big crochet cord also. I can not give you the detailed size, work according your frame, to fix the crochet back Insert, stitch yes, stitch no the cord, push and make a small bow in the back. You can also create a **small chain at the top** to suspend at wall.



Easy...

## **FLOWERS and decorations:**

Some are built with crochet. The small roses, pink flower, leaves.

### **Pink Flower**



**R1-** magic ring, 7 sc in ring. Join

**R2-**ch10, join same st, jump to next st with slip st, again ch10, join same st, repeat the pattern, a ch10 by st.

If you wish more volume work 2 chains (10) at one st, and 1 ch (10) alone at next.

**Leaves :** big is ch10, small is ch7 to start

Ch10, sc in second ch from hook, hdc, 1 dc in next 5, hdc, sc.  
Cross with slip st to the other side, sc, hdc, 1 dc in next 5, hdc, sc.  
For the ch 7 leave is the same, just decrease the dc body(3).

**Small Roses leaves:** just work half side of the pattern.

(Ch7, sc in second ch from hook, hdc, 1 dc in next 3, hdc, sc)

You need 2 like these for the roses.

**Pink Flower Green Base:**

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**R1**-Magic ring, ch4, 3 trebles, ch4 to join down. Build 3 petals as total .

## Small roses:



Make a chain 40 (always multiple of 5). The different sizes you can get changing the yarn/ initial chain or the hook.



Dc in 4th st from hook,dc next st,dc next st,ch3 to join the chain again at next st.

Just where you are start the next rose petal:

ch3, dc next st,dc next st,dc next st,ch3....repeat the pattern to the desired size.

**Roll the flower** (the big chain made with petals)

and sew the back.



## Details:



**Glue some beads and** appliqués also. The “tissue flower” is a decoration, I didn't made it.
