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ABBREVIATIONS
Beg - beginning cm - centimetres cont - continue dec - decrease ins - inches k - knit k2tog - knit 2 sts together meas - measures NR - next row p - purl patt - pattern rep - repeat RS(F) - right side (facing) sl - slip skp - slip 1 st, knit 1 st, pass slipped st over st(s) - stitch(es) Stst - Stocking stitch: Knit on RS and Purl on WS rows tog - together WS(F) - wrong side (facing) yo - yarn over needle

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

TENSION
4ply: 28 sts and 36 rows over Stocking Stitch - 10cm (4ins) on 3.25mm (US 3) needles.
DK/8ply: 22 sts 30 rows over Stocking Stitch - 10cm (4ins) on 4mm (US 6) needles.

SWEATER

worked in one piece and begins at lower Front edge
With 3.25mm (US 3) needles, cast on 57 (63, 71, 77, 85, 91) sts.
K1, p1 rib for 8 (10, 10, 12, 14, 14) rows and inc 1 st at centre of last row to 58 (64, 72, 78, 86, 92) sts.
Stst until piece meas 11.5 (14, 15.5, 18.5, 21, 23)cm/4 ½ (5 ½, 6, 7 ¼, 8 ¼, 9)ins from beg, end with a WS row.
NR (RS) - K58 (64, 72, 78, 86, 92) sts; cast on 36 (42, 48, 54, 65, 73) sts for 1st sleeve - 94 (106, 120, 132, 151, 165) sts.
NR (WS) - K6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, p to end; cast on 36 (42, 48, 54, 65, 73) sts for 2nd sleeve - 130 (148, 168, 186, 216, 238) sts.
NR (RS) - K all sts.
NR (WS) - K6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, p to last 6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, k to end. Rep last 2 rows 2 (2, 3, 3, 4, 4) times more (mark centre of last row).

SPLIT FRONT

NR (RS) - K63 (72, 82, 90, 105, 116) sts (= 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts before marker); do not turn; cast on 4 (4, 4,

6, 6, 6) sts, turn (leave rem sts on holder for right front) – 67 (76, 86, 96, 111, 122) sts.

LEFT FRONT & SLEEVE

NR (WS) – K4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) sts, p to last 6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, k to end.

NR (RS) – K all sts.

Rep last 2 rows until sleeves meas 8.5 (9, 9.5, 10.5, 12, 14) cm/3 ¼ (3 ½, 3 ¾, 4 ¼, 4 ¾, 5 ½)ins from cast on, end with a WS row (body meas 20 (23, 25, 29, 33, 37)cm/7 ¾ (9, 9 ¾, 11 ½, 13, 14 ½)ins from beg).

NR (RS) – K53 (61, 70, 78, 92, 102) sts and place these sts onto a stitch holder; break yarn; slip rem 14 (15, 16, 18, 19, 20) sts onto a separate stitch holder for collar.

RIGHT FRONT & SLEEVE

NR (RS) – Rejoin yarn; k67 (76, 86, 96, 111, 122) sts.

NR (WS) – K6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, p to last 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) sts, k to end.

NR (RS) – K all sts.

Rep last 2 rows until front split meas 2.5 (3, 4, 5, 5, 5)cm/1 (1 ¼, 1 ½, 2, 2, 2)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

NR (RS) – K2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) sts, k2tog, yo twice; k to end.

NR (WS) – K6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, p to split front stitches, k 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) sts and drop 2nd yo off needle. Keeping front split stitches and sleeve edge correct, cont straight until sleeves meas 8.5 (9, 9.5, 10.5, 12, 14)cm/3 ¼ (3 ½, 3 ¾, 4 ¼, 4 ¾, 5 ½) ins from cast on, end with a WS row (body meas 20 (23, 25, 29, 33, 37) cm/7 ¾ (9, 9 ¾, 11 ½, 13, 14 ½)ins from beg).

NR (RS) – K14 (15, 16, 18, 19, 20) sts and slip these just worked sts onto stitch holder for collar, k rem 53 (61, 70, 78, 92, 102) sts.

BACK & SLEEVES

NR (WS) – K6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, p rem 47 (53, 62, 70, 82, 92) sts, do not turn; cast on 24 (26, 28, 30, 32, 34) sts; do not turn; p47 (53, 62, 70, 82, 92) sts of left front holder, k rem 6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts – 130 (148, 168, 186, 216, 238) sts.

NR (RS) – K.

NR (WS) – K6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, p to last 6 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) sts, k to end.

Rep last 2 rows until sleeves meas

17 (18, 19, 21, 24, 28)cm/6 ¾ (7, 7 ½, 8 ¼, 9 ½, 11)ins from cast on of sleeves, end with a WS row (work folded downwards at back neck cast on = 8.5 (9, 9.5, 10.5, 12, 14)cm/3 ¼ (3 ½, 3 ¾, 4 ¼, 4 ¾, 5 ½)ins wide sleeve).

Cast off 36 (42, 48, 54, 65, 73) sts beg next 2 rows – 58 (64, 72, 78, 86, 92) sts.

Stst straight until back meas same as front to rib band, end with a WS row and dec 1 st at centre of last row.

K1, p1 rib for 8 (10, 10, 12, 14, 14) rows.

Cast off loosely (ensure cast off has same stretch as cast on of front).

COLLAR

With RSF and 3.25mm (US 3) needles, slip the right front holder 14 (15, 16, 18, 19, 20) sts onto needle as if they have already been worked; rejoin yarn and pick up and k 24 (26, 28, 30, 32, 34) sts along back neck cast on edge; k the left front holder 14 (15, 16, 18, 19, 20) sts – 52 (56, 60, 66, 70, 74) sts.

Garage Stitch (= k every row) for 6 (7, 8, 9, 9, 10)cm/2 ¾ (2 ¾, 3 ¼, 3 ½, 3 ½, 4)ins.

Cast off **loosely** (use larger needle if required as collar will not sit nice if cast off is too tight).

COMPLETE

Join sleeve and side seams.

Sew the 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) split front cast on sts in behind right front split edge.

Sew on button opposite buttonhole.

HAT

With 3.5mm (US 4) needles, cast on 83 (93, 103, 111, 119, 125) sts.

K1, p1 rib for 10 (12, 12, 14, 14, 16) rows.

Stst until piece meas 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16)cm/4 ½ (4 ¾, 5 ¼, 5 ½, 5 ¾, 6 ¼)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Top

NR (RS) – K7 (8, 7, 9, 9, 10) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k10 (12, 15, 16, 18, 19) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k6 (7, 6, 8, 8, 9) sts – 73 (83, 93, 101, 109, 115) sts.

Beg with a p row on WS, Stst 3 rows.

NR (RS) – K6 (7, 6, 8, 8, 9) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k8 (10, 13,

14, 16, 17) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k5 (6, 5, 7, 7, 8) sts – 63 (73, 83, 91, 99, 105) sts.

Beg with a p row on WS, Stst 3 rows.

NR (RS) – K5 (6, 5, 7, 7, 8) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k6 (8, 11, 12, 14, 15) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k4 (5, 4, 6, 6, 7) sts – 53 (63, 73, 81, 89, 95) sts.

P 1 row.

NR (RS) – K4 (5, 4, 6, 6, 7) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k4 (6, 9, 10, 12, 13) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k3 (4, 3, 5, 5, 6) sts – 43 (53, 63, 71, 79, 85) sts.

P 1 row.

NR (RS) – K3 (4, 3, 5, 5, 6) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k2 (4, 7, 8, 10, 11) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k2 (3, 2, 4, 4, 5) sts – 33 (43, 53, 61, 69, 75) sts.

P 1 row.

NR (RS) – K2 (3, 2, 4, 4, 5) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k0 (2, 5, 6, 8, 9) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k1 (2, 1, 3, 3, 4) sts – 23 (33, 43, 51, 59, 65) sts.

P 1 row.

SIZES 3 months (6-9 months, 12-18 months, 2-3 years, 3-4 years) ONLY

NR (RS) – K2 (1, 3, 3, 4) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k0 (3, 4, 6, 7) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k1 (0, 2, 2, 3) sts – 23 (33, 41, 49, 55) sts.

P 1 row.

SIZES 12-18 months (2-3 years, 3-4 years) ONLY

NR (RS) – K2 (2, 3) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k2 (4, 5) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k1 (1, 2) sts – 31 (39, 45) sts.

P 1 row.

NR (RS) – K1 (1, 2) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; *k0 (2, 3) sts, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k0 (0, 1) sts – 21 (29, 35) sts.

P 1 row.

SIZE 3-4 years ONLY

NR (RS) – K1 st, skp, k2, k2tog; *k1 st, skp, k2, k2tog; rep from * 4 times; k0 st – 25 sts.

P 1 row.

ALL SIZES

NR (RS) – K2tog across row to last st, k1 – 12 (12, 17, 16, 15, 13) sts.

P 1 row.

Break yarn leaving longer end, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off.

Join back seam.

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
