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# **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Beg** - beginning

cm - centimetres

cont - continue

# **CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY**

#### **TENSION**

22 sts and 30 rows over Stst -10cm/4ins on 4mm (US 6) needles.

**CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY** 

#### **BACK**

\*\*With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 88 (94, 100, 106) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - P0 (0, 1, 2), k1 (2, 2, 2), [p2, k2] 3 times; place marker, p2, k4, p3, k2, p3, k4, p2, place marker; k2, [p2, k2] 5 (6, 7, 8) times; place marker, p2, k4, p3, k2, p3, k4, p2, place marker; [k2, p2] 3 times, k1 (2, 2, 2), p0 (0, 1, 2).

Row 2 (WS) - K0 (0, 1, 2), p1 (2, 2, 2), [k2, p2] 3 times; k2, p4, k3, p2, k3, p4, k2; p2, [k2, p2] 5 (6, 7, 8) times; k2, p4, k3, p2, k3, p4, k2; [p2, k2] 3 times, p1 (2, 2, 2), k0 (0, 1, 2).

Rep these 2 rows 6 (6, 7, 7) times more.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

**NR (RS)** - K13 (14, 15, 16); p2, k4, p3, k2, p3, k4, p2; k22 (26, 30, 34); p2, k4, p3, k2, p3, k4, p2; k13 (14, 15, 16).

NR (WS) - P13 (14, 15, 16); k2, p4, k3, p2, k3, p4, k2; p22 (26, 30, 34); k2, p4, k3, p2, k3, p4, k2; p13 (14, 15, 16).

Rep last 2 rows once more.

# **Beg Cable Panels**

**Row 1 (RS)** - K13 (14, 15, 16); p2, C8F, C8B, p2; k22 (26, 30, 34); p2, C8F, C8B, p2; k13 (14, 15, 16).

Row 2 (WS) - P13 (14, 15, 16); k2, p4, k3, p2, k3, p4, k2; p22 (26, 30, 34); k2, p4, k3, p2, k3, p4, k2; p13 (14, 15, 16).

**Row 3** - K13 (14, 15, 16); p2, k4, p3, k2, p3, k4, p2; k22 (26, 30, 34); p2, k4, p3, k2, p3, k4, p2; k13 (14, 15, 16).

**Row 4** - P13 (14, 15, 16); k2, p4, k3, p2, k3, p4, k2; p22 (26, 30, 34); k2, p4, k3, p2, k3, p4, k2; p13 (14, 15, 16).

Rep rows last 2 rows 4 times more. Rep these last 12 rows for Cable Panel patt throughout.

Patt until piece meas 31 (35, 39, 44)cm/12  $\frac{1}{4}$  (13  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 15  $\frac{1}{4}$ , 17  $\frac{1}{4}$ )ins from beg, end with a WS row.

### **Shape Armholes**

Cast off 5 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end next 4 rows, then every other row 3 (3, 4, 4) times - 64 (70, 74, 80) sts.\*\*
Patt straight until piece meas 45 (50, 55, 61)cm/17 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> (19 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 21 ½, 24)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Cast off 16 (18, 19, 21) sts beg next 2 rows.

Leave rem 32 (34, 36, 38) sts on holder for neckband.

#### **FRONT**

Work as for back from \*\* to \*\*. Patt straight until piece meas 36 (41, 46, 52)cm/14  $\frac{1}{4}$  (16  $\frac{1}{4}$ , 18, 20  $\frac{1}{2}$ )ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Mark centre 16 (18, 20, 22) sts of last row.

#### Shape Neck

**NR (RS)** - Patt 24 (26, 27, 29) sts, turn, on these sts only (leave rem sts on hold).

Dec 1 st at neck edge next 6 rows, then every other row twice - 16 (18, 19, 21) sts.

Patt straight until front meas same as back to shoulder, end with a WS row.

Cast off rem 16 (18, 19, 21) shoulder sts.

With RSF, return to sts on hold, slip next 16 (18, 20, 22) sts to holder for front neck, rejoin yarn and patt to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge next 6 rows, then every other row twice - 16 (18, 19, 21) sts.

Patt straight until front meas same as back to shoulder, end with a RS row.

Cast off rem 16 (18, 19, 21) shoulder sts.

#### **SLEEVES**

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 43 (48, 53, 53) sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** – P3; \*k2, p3; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (WS)** – K3; \*p2, k3; rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows 5 (5, 6, 6) times more.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles. Cont in Rib and inc 1 st each end next row, then every  $10^{th}$  ( $11^{th}$ ,  $12^{th}$ ,  $10^{th}$ ) row until 59 (64, 69, 73) sts on needle (take inc sts into rib patt).

Patt straight until sleeve meas 34 (37, 40, 42)cm/13  $\frac{1}{2}$  (14  $\frac{1}{2}$ , 15  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ )ins from beg, end with a WS row.

# **Shape Top**

Cast off 5 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end next 4 rows. Dec 1 st each end next 7 (8, 9, 10) RS rows.

Cast off 5 sts beg next 2 rows. Cast off 4 (5, 6, 7) sts beg next 2 rows - 9 (10, 11, 11) sts. Cast off loosely rem sts.

#### **COMPLETE**

Join left shoulder seam.

#### **NECKBAND**

With RSF and 4mm (US 6) needles, k the back neck holder 32 (34, 36, 38) sts, pick up and k 26 sts down front neck edge, k the front neck holder 16 (18, 20, 22) sts, pick up and k 26 sts up front neck edge - 100 (104, 108, 112) sts.

**Row 1 (WS)** - \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (RS)** - \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rib further 15 (15, 17, 17) rows. Cast off loosely in rib.

Join right shoulder and neckband, allowing half of neckband to fold to RS.

Set in sleeve tops, join side and sleeve seams.
