CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows over Stst – 10cm/4ins on 4mm (US 6) needles.

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

BACK

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 89 (95, 101, 107) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rib further 6 rows and inc 1 st at centre of last row to 90 (96, 102, 108) sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles. Stst until piece meas 48 (53, 58, 63)cm/19 (20 ¾, 22 ¾, 24 ¾)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 10 (10, 10, 11) sts beg next 2 rows, then 9 (10, 11, 12) sts beg foll 4 rows - 34 (36, 38, 38) sts.

Leave rem sts on holder for back neck.

POCKET LINING (make 2)

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 25 (27, 29, 31) sts.

Stst for 10 (10, 12, 12)cm/4 (4, 4 ¾, 4 ¾)ins, end with a WS row. Leave sts on hold.

FRONT

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 89 (95, 101, 107) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rib further 6 rows and inc 1 st at centre of last row to 90 (96, 102, 108) sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles. Stst until piece meas 10 (10, 12, 12)cm/4 (4, 4 ¾, 4 ¾)ins, end with a WS row.

Begin Pocket placement

Row 1 (RS) - K9 sts; p1, [k1, p1] 11 (12, 13, 14) times; k26 (28, 30, 32) sts; p1, [k1, p1] 11 (12, 13, 14) times; k9 sts.

Row 2 (WS) - P9 sts; k1, [p1, k1] 11 (12, 13, 14) times; p26 (28, 30, 32) sts; k1, [p1, k1] 11 (12, 13, 14) times; p9 sts.

Rep these 2 rows once more, then row 1 once.

NR (WS) - P9 sts; cast off 23 (25, 27, 29) sts loosely in rib, with one st already on needle p further 25 (27, 29, 31) sts; cast off 23 (25, 27, 29) sts loosely in rib, p to end.

NR (RS) – K8 sts; *knit together next st with first st of pocket lining, k to last st of pocket lining, knit together next st of front with last st of pocket lining*, k to last st before pocket, rep from * to * once; k to end - 90 (96, 102, 108) sts.

NR (WS) - P.

Stst until front meas 40 (45, 50, 55)cm/15 3 4 (17 3 4, 19 3 4, 21 3 4)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - K38 (41, 43, 46) sts, Turn, on these sts only (leave rem sts on hold), cont in Stst and dec 1 st at neck edge every row until 28 (30, 32, 35) sts rem. Stst straight until front meas

Stst straight until front meas same as back to beg of shoulder shaping, end with a WS row.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 10 (10, 10, 11) sts beg next RS row, then 9 (10, 11, 12) sts beg foll 2 RS rows.

With RSF return to sts on hold, slip next 14 (14, 16, 16) sts to holder for centre front neck, rejoin yarn, k to end.

Cont in Stst and dec 1 st at neck edge every row until 28 (30, 32, 35) sts rem.

Stst straight until front meas same as back to beg of shoulder shaping, end with a RS row.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 10 (10, 10, 11) sts beg next WS row, then 9 (10, 11, 12) sts beg foll 2 WS rows.

SLEEVES

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 43 (47, 49, 51) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more and inc 1 st at centre of last row to 44 (48, 50, 52) sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles. Stst and inc 1 st each end every 7th (7th, 6th, 6th) row until 68 (74, 82, 88) sts on needle.

Stst straight until sleeve meas 34 (37, 40, 42)cm/13 ½ (14 ½,

15 ¾, 16 ½)ins from beg, end with a WS row. Cast off loosely.

COMPLETE

Join left shoulder seam.

NECKBAND

With RSF and 3.75mm (US 5) needles, k the back neck holder 34 (36, 38, 38) sts, pick up and k24 (24, 26, 26) sts down neck edge, k the front neck holder 14 (14, 16, 16) sts, pick up and k24 (24, 26, 26) sts up front neck edge - 96 (98, 106, 106) sts. K1, p1 rib for 17 rows.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Join right shoulder and neckband. Sew pocket lining in place.

Fold sleeve top in half, and pin to shoulder seam edge, join sleeve top evenly to back and front, stretching sleeve top as you sew. Join side and sleeve seams.
