TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows over Stst - 10cm x 10cm/4ins x 4ins on 4mm (US 6) needles.

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

COWL

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 151 (171) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - P2; *k2, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p2.

Row 2 (WS) - K2, p2; *k3, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Rib 6 more rows.

Beg Main Pattern

()Row 1 (RS)** - P all sts.

Row 2 (WS) - K all sts.

Row 3 - *K2, p7, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 4 - P1; *p2, k5, p3; rep from * to end.

Row 5 - *K4, p3, k3; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 6 - P1; *p3, k3, p4; rep from * to end.

Row 7 - As row 5.

Row 8 - As row 6.

Row 9 - *K3, p5, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 10 - P1; *p1, k7, p2; rep from * to end.

Row 11 - P all sts.

Row 12 - K all sts.

Row 13 - *P4, k3, p3; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 14 - K1; *k2, p5, k3; rep from * to end.

Rows 15 & 17 - *P2, k7, p1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rows 16 & 18 - K1; *k1, p7, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 19 - *P3, k5, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 20 - K1; *k3, p3, k4; rep from * to end. (**)

Rep these 20 rows 1 (2) times more, then rows 1-12 once.

NR (RS) - P2; *k2, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p2.

NR (WS) - K2, p2; *k3, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Rib 6 more rows.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Join back seam.

HAT 1

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 101 (111) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - P2; *k2, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p2.

Row 2 (WS) - K2, p2; *k3, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Rib 8 (10) more rows.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg Main Pattern

Work as for cowl from (**) to (**) 2 (3) times.

Shape Top

Row 1 (RS) - *P1, p2tog, p5, p2tog; rep from * to last st, p1 - 81 (89) sts.

Row 2 (WS) - K.

Row 3 - P.

Rows 4, 6, 8 & 10 - K.

Row 5 - *P1, p2tog, p3, p2tog; rep from * to last st, p1 - 61 (67) sts.

Row 7 - *P1, p2tog, p1, p2tog; rep from * to last st, p1 - 41 (45) sts.

Row 9 - *P1, p2tog; rep from * to last 2 (3) sts, p2 (3) - 28 (31) sts.

Row 11 - P2tog across, end p0 (1) - 14 (16) sts.

Row 12 - K.

Break yarn, leaving longer end, draw end through rem sts, pull together, secure end.

Join back seam.

HAT 2

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles and A, cast on 102 (114) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - *K2, p2; rep from * to last st, k2.

Row 2 (WS) - P2; *k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rib 8 (10) more rows.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg Main Pattern

Row 1 (RS) - K all sts.

Row 2 (WS) - P all sts.

Row 3 - K2, p2; rep from * to last st, k2.

Row 4 - P2; *k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep last 4 rows 5 (6) times more.

Change to B.
Cont in patt until piece meas 17 (20)cm/6 ¾ (7 ¾)ins from beg, end with a row 2 of patt.

Shape Top

Row 1 (RS) - *K1, skp, k5, k2tog; rep from * to last 2 (4) sts, k2 (4) - 82 (92) sts.

Rows 2, 4, 6 & 8 (WS) - P.

Row 3 - *K1, skp, k3, k2tog; rep from * to last 2 (4) sts, k2 (4) - 62 (70) sts.

Row 5 - *K1, skp, k1, k2tog; rep from * to last 2 (4) sts, k2 (4) - 42 (48) sts.

Row 7 - *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end - 28 (32) sts.

Row 9 - K2tog across row - 14 (16) sts.

Row 10 - P.

Break yarn, leaving longer end, draw end through rem sts, pull together, secure end.

Join back seam.

Using remaining A & B, make pompom of approx 7 (9)cm/ 2 ¾ (3 ½)ins diameter and attach to top of hat.

HAT 3

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 106 (122) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *k2, p4, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *p2, k4, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rib 6 (8) more rows.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg Main Pattern

Rows 1, 3 & 5 (RS) - K1; *k2, p4, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Rows 2, 4 & 6 (WS) - P1; *p2, k4, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 7 - K all sts.

Row 8 - P all sts.

Row 9 - K1; *slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold at back of work, k2, p2 from cable needle, slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, p2, k2 from cable needle; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 10 - P1; *p2, k4, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep these 10 rows 3 (4) times more.

Shape Top

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *k2, p1, p2tog, p1, k2; rep from * to last st, k1 - 93 (107) sts.

Rows 2 & 4 - P1; *p2, k3, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 3 - K1; *k2, p3, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 5 - K1; *k2, p2tog, p1, k2; rep from * to last st, k1 - 80 (92) sts.

Row 6 - P1; *p2, k2, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 7 - K1; *k2, p2tog, k2; rep from * to last st, k1 - 67 (77) sts.

Row 8 - P1; *p2, k1, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 9 - K1; *k2tog, p1, skp; rep from * to last st, k1 - 41 (47) sts.

Row 10 - P1; *p1, k1, p1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 11 - K2tog; *p1, k2tog; rep from * to end - 27 (31) sts.

Row 12 - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 13 - K2tog across, end k1 - 14 (16) sts.

Row 14 - P.

Break yarn, leaving longer end, draw end through rem sts, pull together, secure end.

Join back seam.

HAT 4

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles and A, cast on 107 (121) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K2; *p1, k3, p1, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P2; *k1, p3, k1, p2; rep from * to end.

Rib 8 (10) more rows.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

When working Main Pattern, do not break of A, B or C, carry colour not in use loosely up side.

Beg Main Pattern

Row 1 (RS) - Using A, k1; *k2, yo, s2kp, yo, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS) - Knit all sts.

Row 3 - Using B, knit all sts.

Row 4 - Purl all sts.

Row 5 - Using A, k1; *k2, yo, s2kp, yo, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 6 - Knit all sts.

Row 7 - Using C, knit all sts.

Row 8 - Purl all sts.

Rep these 8 rows until piece meas 17 (20)cm/6 $\frac{3}{4}$ (7 $\frac{3}{4}$)ins from beg, end with a row 2 or 6 of patt.

Shape Top

NR (RS) - Using B or C (depending what colour is next), knit all sts.

NR (WS) - P2; *p5, p2tog; rep from * to last 7 sts, p7 - 93 (105) sts.

NR - Using A, k3, yo, s2kp, yo, k2; *k1, yo, s2kp, yo, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

NR - Knit all sts.

NR (RS) - Using B or C (depending what colour is next), knit all sts.

NR (WS) - P2; *p4, p2tog; rep from * to last st, p1 - 78 (88) sts.

NR - Using A, k2; *yo, s2kp, yo, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

NR - Knit all sts.

NR (RS) - Using B or C (depending what colour is next), knit all sts.

NR (WS) - *P2, p2tog; rep from * to last 2 (4) sts, p2 (4) - 59 (67) sts.

Using A, knit 2 rows.

NR (RS) - Using B or C (depending what colour is next), knit all sts.

NR (WS) - *P1, p2tog; rep from * to last 2 (1) sts, p2 (1) - 40 (45) sts.

Using A, knit 2 rows.

NR - K2tog across row, end k0 (1) - 20 (23) sts.

NR - P.

Break yarn, leaving longer end, draw end through rem sts, pull together, secure end.

Join back seam.
