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ABBREVIATIONS
k – knit p – purl sts – stitch(es) c/on – cast on c/off – cast off st st – stocking stitch RS – right side WS – wrong side dec – decrease ssk – slip next 2 sts one at a time as if to knit onto right hand needle, then knit them together through the back of the loops k2tog – knit 2 sts together rem – remaining rep – repeat cont – continue fol – following pm – place marker mm – move marker cdd -centered double decrease: slip next 2 sts one at a time as if to knit, k1, pull two slipped sts over the knit stitch Sm – slip marker kf&b – knit into the front and the back of the next stitch

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

Tension: 24 sts x 30 rows to 10cm stocking stitch on 3.75mm needles.

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

This garment is knit to and fro to the armhole division. The skirt is knit in the round. The bodice has a CB opening that closes with one button.

NOTE: When casting on at the start, leave a long tail (at least 30cm) to start as this will be used for the button loop in the back.

Knit from the top down.

METHOD
Using 3.25mm needles and Col B c/on 66 (71, 77, 80, 85, 88, 93) sts. Knit 1 row.
Next row: sl 1, k12 (13, 14, 14, 15, 15, 16), pm, k7 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13), pm, k26 (27, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33), pm, k7 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13), pm, k13 (14, 15, 15, 16, 16, 17).
Next row: sl 1, k to 1 stitch before the marker, kfb, sm, kfb, k to 1 stitch before next marker, kfb, sm, kfb, k to 1 stitch before next marker, kfb, sm, kfb, k to 1 stitch before next marker, kfb, sm, kfb, k to the end of the row.
Next row: sl1, k to the end of the row.
Rep last two rows twice. (total 8 rows garter stitch in Col B). [90, (95, 101, 104, 109, 112, 117) sts] Change to 3.75mm needles and Col A.

Next row: sl 1, k to 1 stitch before the marker, kfb, sm, kfb, k to 1 stitch before next marker, kfb, sm, kfb, k to 1 stitch before next marker, kfb, sm, kfb, k to the end of the row.

Next row: sl1, k3, p to last 4 sts, k4.

Rep last two rows until there are 170 (183, 196, 208, 221, 232, 237) sts.

Separate Body and Sleeves

Next row: sl1, k to first marker, remove the marker, slip the next 33 (36, 39, 42, 45, 48, 49) sts onto waste yarn, knit to the next marker, remove the marker, slip the next 33 (36, 39, 42, 45, 48, 49) sts onto waste yarn, knit to the end of the row. Place a marker and continue to work in the round from this point on. [104 (111, 118, 124, 131, 136, 139) sts].

Change to 3.25mm needles and Col B knit one round.

Next round: purl in Col B

Next round: knit in Col B

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Change to 3.75mm and Col A.

Next round: knit to the end of the round increasing 26 (29, 22, 26, 19, 24, 21) sts evenly spaced in this round. [130 (140, 140,

150, 150, 160, 160) sts].

Next round: knit.

Continue in Col A and begin lace pattern as follows:

Round 1: *k3, k2tog, yf, k5, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 2 and every even round: knit.

Round 3: *k2, k2tog, yf, k1, yf, ssk, k3, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 5: *k1, k2tog, yf, k3, yf, ssk, k2, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 7: *k2tog, yf, k5, yf, ssk, k1, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 9: *yf, k7, yf, cdd, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 11: *ssk, k8, yf, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 13: *yf, ssk, k5, k2tog, yf, k1, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 15: *k1, yf, ssk, k3, k2tog, yf, k2, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 17: *k2, yf, ssk, k1, k2tog, yf, k3, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 19: *k3, yf cdd, yf, k4, rep from * to the end of the round.

Round 20: knit.

Rep rounds 1-20: 2 (3, 4, 4, 5, 6) times.

Change to Col B and **knit one round.**

Next round: purl.

Next round: knit.

Rep last two rounds once more.

Next round: knit.

C/off pwise loosely.

SLEEVES

With 3.25mm needles transfer stitches from waste yarn to needles. Attach Col B and **knit one round.**

Next round: purl.

Next round: knit.

Rep last two rounds once more.

Next round: knit.

C/off pwise loosely.

FINISHING

Sew a button onto the CB. With the long tail from cast on, make a button loop to fit the button.

If there is a gap at the underarm, stitch it closed.

Sew away any ends.



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
