CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

Tension: 22sts x 28 rows to 10cm stocking stitch on 4.00mm needles.

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

NOTE: The yoke is knit in one in the round.

METHOD

BACK

With 3.25mm needles and Col A, c/on 86 (90, 94, 98) sts.

Row 1: *k2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: *p2, k2, rep from * to the end of the row

Rep row 1 and 2 until work measures 4 cm. End with a knit row.

Next row: p6 (2, 4, 4, 6), p2tog, [p4 (4, 4, 5, 5) p2tog] x 12 (14, 14, 12, 12), p6 (2, 4, 4, 6). [73 (75, 79, 81, 85) sts].

Change to 4.00mm needles.

Begin with a knit row work in st st until piece measures 13 (13, 14, 15, 15) cm. End with RS facing.

Change to Col B.

Begin with a knit row work in st st until piece measures 23 (25, 26, 28, 29) cm. End with RS facing.

Change to Col C

SHAPE RAGLAN

C/off 4 (4, 5, 5, 6) sts at the beginning of the next two rows. [65 (67, 69, 71, 73) sts]

1st size only

Row 1: k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (63 sts)

Row 2: purl

Row 3: knit.

Row 4: purl.

4th and 5th sizes only

Row 1: k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [69 (71) sts]

Row 2: p1, p2tog, p to last 3 sts, p2togtbl, p1. [67 (69) sts]

Rep last 2 rows 0 (1) more time. [67 (65) sts].

Stitch count to here is: 63 (67, 69, 67, 65) sts

1st, 2nd, and 3rd sizes only

Row 1: k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [61 (65, 67) sts]

Row 2: purl.

Rep last two rows 1 (1, 1) times. [59 (63, 65) sts]

Place these 59 (63, 65, 67, 65) sts on a stitch holder. **

FRONT

Work same as BACK to **

SLEEVES (both alike)

With 3.25mm needles and Col A, c/on 46 (46, 50, 50, 50) sts.

Row 1: *k2, p2, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: *p2, k2, rep from * to the end of the row

Rep row 1 and 2 until work measures 4 cm.

End with a knit row.

Next row: p4 (4, 6, 6, 6), p2tog, [p3 (3, 2, 2, 2) p2tog] x 7 (7, 9, 9, 9), p5 (5, 6, 6, 6). [38 (38, 40, 40, 40) sts].

Change to 4.00mm needles.

1st size only

Work 16 rows st st, increasing 1 st at each end of the 7th and every following 4th row until there are 44 sts.

All Sizes

Work 24 (40, 46, 48, 50) rows, increasing 1 st at each end of 5th (7th, 7th, 7th, 7th) row, then each end of every following 6th row to 52 (50, 54, 54, 56) sts.

Change to Col B.

Work 17 (15, 21, 25, 11) rows, increasing 1 st each end of the 5th (3rd, 3rd, 1st , 5th) row, then every following 6th (6th, 6th, 8th, 6th) row. [58 (56, 62, 62, 60) sts].

2nd and 5th sizes only

Work 8 (16) rows increasing 1 st each end of every following 8th row. [58 (64) sts]

All Sizes

Cont without any shaping until sleeve measures 26 (28, 32, 33) cm, ending with a purl row.

Change to Col C.

SHAPE RAGLAN

C/off 4 (4, 5, 5, 6) sts at the beginning of the next two rows. [50 (50, 52, 52, 52) sts]

Row 1: k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. [48 (48, 50, 50, 50) sts]

Row 2: purl

Row 3: knit.

Row 4: purl.

1st size only

Row 1: k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (46 sts)

Row 2: purl

Rep last two rows once more. (44 sts)

Place 44 (48, 50, 50, 50) sleeve sts on a stitch holder.

SETTING UP THE YOKE TO KNIT IN THE ROUND

With 4.00mm circular needles and RS facing, begin at right back raglan.

Knit across 59 (63, 65, 67, 65) sts from stitch holder of back, place a marker, knit left 44 (48, 50, 50, 50) sleeve stitches, place a marker, knit across 59 (63, 65, 67, 65) from stitch holder of front, place a marker, knit across right 44 (48, 50, 50, 50) sleeve stitches. Place a marker. The last marker indicates the begin of the round. [206 (222, 230, 234, 230) sts]

Work one round decreasing 0 (0, 0, 4, 0) sts evenly spaced. [206 (222, 230, 230, 230) sts]

Round 1: k1, ssk, *k to 3 sts before next marker, k2tog, k1, mm, k1, ssk, rep from * twice,

k to 3 sts before next marker, k2tog, k1. (8 sts decreased) [198 (214, 222, 222, 222) sts]

Round 2: knit.

Rep rounds 1 and 2 until there are 70 sts left. You will have decreased 16 (18, 19, 19, 19) times.

Work one round decreasing 2 sts evenly spaced. (68 sts)

NECK

Change to 3.25mm circular needles (or DPNs). Cont in Col C. Next round: *k2, p2, rep from * to the end of the round.

Rep last round until neck rib measures 2 cm.

C/off in pattern.

FINISHING

Join side seams and underarm seams.

Sew away any ends.

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
