CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

TENSION
22 sts 30 rows over Stocking Stitch - 10cm (4ins) on 4mm (US 6) needles.

JACKET

BACK
With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 45 (51, 57, 63, 69, 75) sts.
Gtst for 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) rows.
Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.
Beg Main Pattern.
Row 1 (RS) - K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.
Row 2 (WS) - P1, *k, p1; rep from * to end.
Gtst 4 rows.
Rep these 6 rows until piece meas 20 (23, 25, 29, 33, 37)cm/7 ¾ (9, 9 ¾, 11 ½, 13, 14 ½)ins from beg, end with a WS row.
Cast off loosely, mark centre 19 (23, 27, 29, 31, 31) sts for back neck.

LEFT FRONT
With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 27 (29, 31, 35, 39, 41) sts.
Gtst for 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) rows.
Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg Main Pattern.

Row 1 (RS) - K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Gtst 4 rows.

Rep these 6 rows until piece meas 10 (12, 13, 16, 19, 22)cm/4 (4 $\frac{3}{4}$, 5 $\frac{1}{8}$, 6 $\frac{1}{4}$, 7 $\frac{1}{2}$, 8 $\frac{3}{4}$)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - Patt to last 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts, slip those last 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts onto stitch holder; TURN.

NR (WS) - Patt.

NR (RS) - Patt to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

NR (WS) - Patt.

NR (RS) - Patt to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

NR (WS) - Patt.

Patt 2 rows straight.

Cont to dec as established in last 6 rows 2 (3, 3, 3, 4, 4) times more - 15 (15, 17, 19, 21, 23) sts.

NR (RS) - Patt to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

NR (WS) - Patt.

Patt 2 rows straight.

Cont to dec as established in last 4 rows 1 (0, 1, 1, 1, 0) times more - 13 (14, 15, 17, 19, 22) sts.

Patt straight until front meas same as back to shoulder, end with a WS row.

Cast off loosely rem 13 (14, 15, 17, 19, 22) sts.

Place first button marker 2 (2, 3, 3, 4, 4)cm/ $\frac{3}{4}$ ($\frac{3}{4}$, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$, 1 $\frac{1}{4}$, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$)ins from cast-on edge, the last 6 rows below sts on hold for collar and the rem evenly in between.

RIGHT FRONT

NOTE: Work buttonholes at beg of RS row opposite markers as following: Patt 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3), k2tog, yo twice, patt to end of row; and on the following WS row patt only into one of every double yo and drop the 2nd yo off needle.

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 27 (29, 31, 35, 39, 41) sts.

Gtst for 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) rows.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg Main Pattern.

Row 1 (RS) - K1, *p1, k1; rep

from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Gtst 4 rows.

Rep these 6 rows until piece meas 10 (12, 13, 16, 19, 22)cm/4 (4 $\frac{3}{4}$, 5 $\frac{1}{8}$, 6 $\frac{1}{4}$, 7 $\frac{1}{2}$, 8 $\frac{3}{4}$)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - Patt 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts, slip those 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts onto stitch holder; patt to end.

NR (WS) - Patt.

NR (RS) - K2, skp, patt to end.

NR (WS) - Patt.

NR (RS) - K2, skp, patt to end.

NR (WS) - Patt.

Patt 2 rows straight.

Cont to dec as established in last 6 rows 2 (3, 3, 3, 4, 4) times more - 15 (15, 17, 19, 21, 23) sts.

NR (RS) - K2, skp, patt to end.

NR (WS) - Patt.

Patt 2 rows straight.

Cont to dec as established in last 4 rows 1 (0, 1, 1, 1, 0) times more - 13 (14, 15, 17, 19, 22) sts.

Patt straight until front meas same as back to shoulder, end with a RS row.

Cast off loosely rem 13 (14, 15, 17, 19, 22) sts.

SLEEVES

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 29 (31, 33, 35, 37, 39) sts.

Gtst 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) rows.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg Main Pattern.

Row 1 (RS) - K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1, *k, p1; rep from * to end.

Gtst 4 rows.

Rep these 6 rows and inc 1 st each end next row, then every 5th (5th, 6th, 5th, 6th, 6th) row until 39 (43, 45, 49, 53, 59) sts on needle.

Patt straight until sleeve meas 13 (15, 17, 19, 23, 26)cm/5 (6, 6 $\frac{3}{4}$, 7 $\frac{1}{2}$, 9, 10 $\frac{1}{4}$)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Cast off loosely.

COMPLETE

Join shoulders.

Mark centre back neck.

COLLAR

Slip the left front holder sts to

4mm (US 6) needles, ensure next row will be a RS row.

Cont in Gtst and inc 1 st at beg of every other RS row (= 1 inc within 4 rows) until 16 (17, 18, 20, 21, 22) sts on needle.

Gtst straight until piece easily fits along shaped front neck edge to centre back neck marker (do not stretch, otherwise neckband will pull at back neck).

Cast off.

Slip the right front holder sts to 4mm (US 6) needles, ensure next row will be a WS row.

Cont in Gtst and inc 1 st at end of every other RS row (= 1 inc within 4 rows) until 16 (17, 18, 20, 21, 22) sts on needle.

Gtst straight until piece easily fits along shaped front neck edge to centre back neck marker (do not stretch, otherwise neckband will pull at back neck).

Cast off.

Join back seam of collar.

Sew collar in place.

Place marker 9 (10, 11, 12, 13, 14)cm/3 $\frac{1}{2}$ (4, 4 $\frac{1}{4}$, 4 $\frac{3}{4}$, 5, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$) ins down from shoulder on front and back.

Join sleeve top to body from marker to marker.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Sew on buttons opposite buttonholes.

HAT

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 69 (73, 81, 87, 93, 99) sts.

Gtst for 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 8) rows.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Beg Main Pattern.

Row 1 (RS) - K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1, *k, p1; rep from * to end.

Gtst 4 rows.

Rep these 6 rows until piece meas 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16)cm/4 $\frac{1}{2}$ (4 $\frac{3}{4}$, 5 $\frac{1}{4}$, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$, 5 $\frac{3}{4}$, 6 $\frac{1}{4}$)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Top

NR (RS) - K2 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2); [k2tog, k4] 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times; k1 (0, 1, 1, 1, 1) - 58 (61, 68, 73, 78, 83) sts.

Gtst 3 rows.

NR (RS) - K2 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2); [k2tog, k3] 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times; k1 (0, 1, 1, 1, 1) - 47

(49, 55, 59, 63, 67) sts.

Gtst 3 rows.

NR (RS) – K2 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2);
[k2tog, k2] 11 (12, 13, 14, 15,
16) times; k1 (0, 1, 1, 1, 1) - 36
(37, 42, 45, 48, 51) sts.

Gtst 3 rows.

NR (RS) – K2 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2);
[k2tog, k1] 11 (12, 13, 14, 15,
16) times; k1 (0, 1, 1, 1, 1) - 25

(25, 29, 31, 33, 35) sts.

K 1 row.

NR (RS) – K2tog across row, end
k1 – 13 (13, 15, 16, 17, 18) sts.

K 1 row.

Break yarn leaving longer end,
thread yarn through rem sts,
draw up tightly and fasten off.

Join back seam.
