## CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

## TENSION

22 sts 30 rows over Stocking Stitch - 10cm (4ins) on 4mm (US 6) needles.

## CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

## BACK

\*\*With 3.75mm (US 5) needles and A, cast on 45 (51, 55, 61, 67, 73) sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** - K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (WS)** - P1, \*kl, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4) times more and inc 1 st at centre of last row to 46 (52, 56, 62, 68, 74) sts.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

(\*)B, Stst 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 10) rows.

A, Stst 4 (6, 6, 6, 8, 8) rows.

B, Stst 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 8) rows.

A, Stst 2 (4, 4, 4, 6, 6) rows.

B, Stst 2 (2, 2, 4, 4, 6) rows.

A, Stst 2 (2, 2, 2, 4, 4) rows.

B, Stst 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 2, 4) rows.

A, Stst 0 (0, 0, 0, 0, 2, 2) rows. (\*)

Using B from here on only, cont in Stst until piece meas 10 (12, 13, 16, 18, 21)cm/4 (4 ¾, 5, 6 ¼, 7, 8 ¼)ins from beg, end with a WS row.\*\*

### Shape Raglan Armholes

Cast off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4) sts beg next 2 rows - 40 (46, 50, 54, 60, 66) sts.

**NR (RS)** - K1, skp, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

**NR (WS)** - P.

Rep last 2 rows 10 (12, 13, 14, 16, 19) times more - 18 (20, 22, 24, 26, 26) sts.

Leave rem 18 (20, 22, 24, 26, 26) sts on hold for back neck.

### FRONT

Work as for back from \*\* to \*\*.

### Shape Raglan Armholes

Cast off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4) sts beg next 2 rows - 40 (46, 50, 54, 60, 66) sts.

**NR (RS)** - K1, skp, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

**NR (WS)** - P.

Rep last 2 rows 5 (7, 7, 8, 8, 11) times more - 28 (30, 34, 36, 42, 42) sts.

Mark centre 4 (6, 6, 8, 6, 6) sts of last row.

**NR (RS)** - K1, skp, k to 2 sts before marked centre sts, k2tog, TURN, on these sts only, leave rem sts (and centre sts on hold).

**NR (WS)** - P.

**NR (RS)** - K1, skp, k to last 2 sts, k2tog.

**NR (WS)** - P.

Rep last 2 rows 1 (1, 2, 2, 4, 4) times more - 6 sts rem.

**NR (RS)** - K1, skp, k1, k2tog.

**NR (WS)** - P.

**NR (RS)** - K1, skp, k1.

**NR (WS)** - P2tog, p1.

**NR (RS)** - K2tog, fasten off.

With RSF, return to sts on hold and slip the marked centre 4 (6, 6, 8, 6, 6) sts to stitch holder, rejoin yarn, skp, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

**NR (WS)** - P.

**NR (RS)** - Skp, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

**NR (WS)** - P.

Rep last 2 rows 1 (1, 2, 2, 4, 4) times more - 6 sts rem.

**NR (RS)** - Skp, k1, k2tog, k1.

**NR (WS)** - P.

**NR (RS)** - K1, k2tog, k1.

**NR (WS)** - P1, p2tog.

**NR (RS)** - K2tog, fasten off.

### SLEEVES

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles and A, cast on 29 (31, 33, 35, 37, 39) sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** - K1, \*p1, k1; rep

from \* to end.

**Row 2 (WS)** - P1, \*kl, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) times more.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles. Inc 1 st each end next row, then every 5th row until 37 (41, 45, 49, 55, 61) sts on needle, AND AT THE SAME TIME work stripes as for Back from (\*) to (\*), then cont in B only until sleeve meas 13 (15, 17, 19, 23, 26)cm/5 (6, 6 ¾, 7 ½, 9, 10 ¼)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

### Shape Raglan Sleeve Top

Cast off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4) sts beg next 2 rows - 31 (35, 39, 41, 47, 53) sts.

**NR (RS)** - K1, skp, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

**NR (WS)** - P.

Rep last 2 rows 10 (12, 13, 14, 16, 19) times more - 9 (9, 11, 11, 13, 13) sts.

Leave rem sts on holder.

### NECKBAND

With RSF and 3.75mm (US 5) needles and B, pick up and k8 (8, 10, 10, 11, 12) sts down front neck edge, k the 4 (6, 6, 8, 6, 6) sts from front neck holder, pick up and k8 (8, 10, 10, 11, 12) sts up front neck, k the 9 (9, 11, 11, 13, 13) sts from first sleeve top holder, k across the 18 (20, 22, 24, 26, 26) sts from back neck holder, k the 9 (9, 11, 11, 13, 13) sts from 2nd sleeve top - 56 (60, 70, 74, 80, 82) sts.

P1, k1 rib for 7 (7, 7, 9, 9, 9) rows.

Cast off loosely in rib.

### COMPLETE

Join raglan seams except left front raglan seam.

Join lower left front raglan seam, leaving upper 8 (8, 10, 10, 12, 12)cm/3 ¼ (3 ¼, 4, 4, 4 ¾, 4 ¾) ins open (incl neckband).

Join side and sleeve seams.

### BUTTONBAND

With RSF and 3.75mm (US 5) needles and B, pick up and k21 (21, 25, 25, 29, 29) sts down left front sleeve raglan edge including neckband.

**Row 1 (WS)** - P1, \*kl, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (RS)** - K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Cast off loosely in rib.

### BUTTONHOLE BAND

With RSF and 3.75mm (US 5) needles and B, pick up and k21 (21, 25, 25, 29, 29) sts up left front raglan edge including neckband.

**Row 1 (WS)** - P1, \*kl, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (RS)** - K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rib 1 (1, 1, 1, 3, 3) more rows.

**Row 4 (RS)** - Rib 1 st, [rib 6 (6, 8, 8, 6, 6) k2tog, yo twice] 2 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3) times; rib 4.

**Row 5 (WS)** - Rib across but rib only into every first yo, drop every 2nd yo off needle.

Rib 1 more row.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Sew lower side edge of buttonhole band in place.

Sew on buttons.

### HAT

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles and A, cast on 69 (75, 81, 87, 93, 99) sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** - K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (WS)** - P1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows 3 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5) times more.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

B, Stst 4 (6, 6, 6, 8, 8) rows.

A, Stst 4 (6, 6, 6, 6, 6) rows.

B, Stst 2 (4, 4, 4, 6, 6) rows.

A, Stst 2 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows.

B, Stst 2 (2, 2, 2, 4, 4) rows.

A, Stst 2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2) rows.

Using B from here on only, cont in Stst until piece meas 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16)cm/4 ½ (4 ¾, 5 ¼, 5 ½, 5 ¾, 6 ¼)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

### Shape Top

**NR (RS)** - K2; [k2tog, k4] 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times; k1 - 58 (63, 68, 73, 78, 83) sts.

Beg with a purl row on WS, Stst 3 rows.

**NR (RS)** - K2; [k2tog, k3] 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times; k1 - 47 (51, 55, 59, 63, 67) sts.

Beg with a purl row on WS, Stst 3 rows.

**NR (RS)** - K2; [k2tog, k2] 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times; k1 - 36 (39, 42, 45, 48, 51) sts.

**NR (WS)** - P.

**NR (RS)** - K2; [k2tog, k1] 11

(12, 13, 14, 15, 16) times; k1 - 25 (27, 29, 31, 33, 35) sts.

**NR (WS)** – P.

**NR (RS)** – K2tog across row, end k1 – 13 (14, 15, 16, 17, 18) sts.

**NR (WS)** – P.

Break yarn leaving longer end, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off.

Join back seam.
