

Button Necklace

This cute button necklace is quick and easy to crochet. Pick out a wild rainbow of buttons or an elegant selection of mellow hues. Include size variation, or use buttons of the same size. Consider a statement button to place front-and-center. It's up to you!

👑 Materials 👑

Yarn – Cascade 220 Fingering
or other fingering-weight yarn

Hook – US C crochet hook

Notions – 20-50 buttons, darning needle

Size – Customizable length

👑 Skills Needed 👑

chain stitch

String The Buttons

With fingering weight yarn, pre-string desired number of buttons in and size, shape or color of your choice. Make sure the buttons are several yards down the working yarn from the end.

Crochet One or More Strands

Chain 10. Slide a button up snug against your hook and chain across it. Chain 5-10 stitches (depending on the size of the buttons and how you want to space them). Place another button and chain across it. Keep chaining and placing buttons in this manner until desired length.

Make two or more strands in this manner.

Finish

When your strands are completed, slip stitch through one end of each strand, bringing all strands together at one end. Chain until desired length, slip stitch into 10th chain stitch from the hook to form a button loop. Fasten off and weave in end. Slip stitch into the other end of all strands, bringing all strands together at one end. Chain until desired length.

Place one button as before, chain 1-2 more stitches. Fasten off and weave in ends.
