

Crochet Flower Bookmark

Materials:

- (leftover) yarn in the colors you prefer
- scissors
- 2.5 mm crochet hook
- needle

Notes:

- I used a 2.5mm crochet hook to make this flower
- The pattern is written in US term



The first lager flower

Start by making a magic ring

Make 10 dc into the magic ring

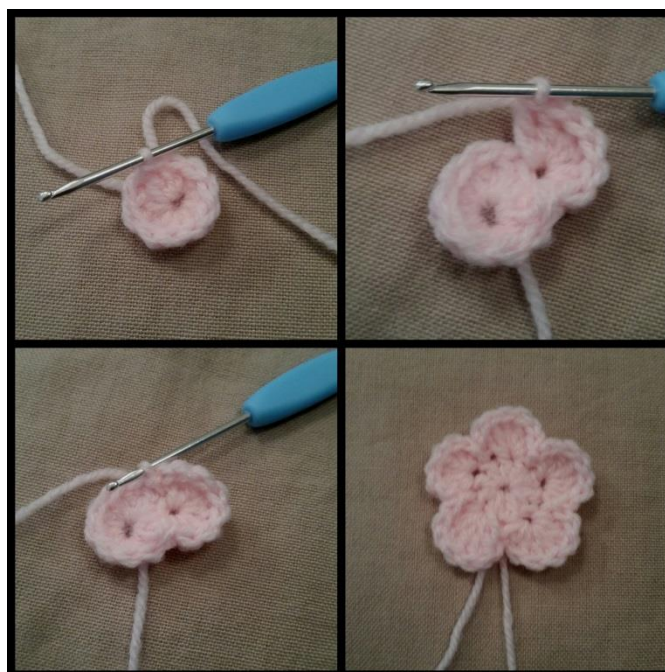
Close the ring and slipstitch into the first stitch

To create the first petal: make 6 dc into the same stitch as the slipstitch, chain 1, slipstitch into the next stitch

To create the second, third, fourth and fifth petal: *make 6 dc into the next stitch, chain 1, slipstitch into the next stitch – repeat from *

The slipstitch of the fifth petal is worked into the first stitch. *(I personally also like to slipstitch into the back of the flower to make sure the petal is nicely rounded at the bottom)*

Bind off and cut the yarn and weave in the ends



The second smaller flower

Start by making a magic ring

Make 10 sc into the magic ring

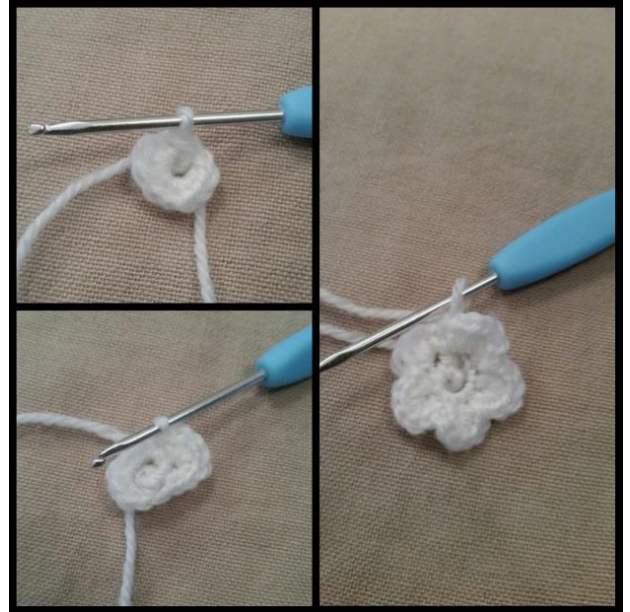
Close the ring and slipstitch into the first stitch

To create the first petal: make 6 sc into the same stitch as the slipstitch, slipstitch into the next stitch

To create the second, third, fourth and fifth petal:

*make 6 sc into the next stitch, slipstitch into the next stitch – repeat from *

The slipstitch of the fifth petal is worked into the first stitch



Bind off and cut the yarn leaving a long enough tail to attach



Attach the smaller flower to the larger one

Place the smaller flower on top of the larger flower and sew the two together. Weave in the ends.

The flower stem

To make the stem of the flower you need to place the flower with the right side down. Find two loops near the edge and insert your hook into both of the loops. Yarn over and pull up a loop. (Use the yarn tail to secure everything tight in place) Chain as many chains as you need to make your desired stem length.



The leaf at the end

In the last stitches of the stem you will make a leaf.

Start in the second chain from the hook.

sc, hdc, 2dc, 2dc, hdc, sc, chain 1 and turn

Into the back loops of your leaf you will make the other side of your leaf. Start in the back loop of the last sc.

sc, hdc, 2dc, 2dc, hdc, sc, slipstitch into the first stitch

Bind off the yarn and weave in the ends.
