CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows over Stst -10cm x 10cm/4ins x 4ins on 4mm (US 6) needles.

CHECK YOUR TENSION CAREFULLY

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 79 (85, 91, 97) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 3 - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 4 - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep these 4 rows 1 (2, 2, 2) times more, then work rows 1&2 (0, 0, 1&2) once.

Cont in Stst until piece meas 15 (18, 21, 24)cm/6 (7, 8 ¼, 9 ½)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 5 sts beg next 2 rows.

Dec 1 st each end next 4 rows, then every other row 3 (3, 4, 4) times - 55 (61, 65, 71) sts.

Stst straight until piece meas 28 (32, 36, 40)cm/11 (12 ½, 14 ¼, 15 ¾)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Cast off 12 (14, 15, 17) sts beg next 2 rows.

Leave rem 31 (33, 35, 37) sts on holder for neckband.

LEFT FRONT

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 33 (35, 39, 41) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 3 - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 4 - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep these 4 rows 1 (2, 2, 2) times more, then work rows 1&2 (0, 0, 1&2) once.

NR (RS) - K to last 6 sts, M1, patt 6.

NR (WS) - Patt 6, p28 (30, 34, 36) sts.

NR (RS) - K to last 6 sts, patt 6. NR (WS) - Patt 6, p to end.

SIZES 8 & 10 years only

Cont in this manner, keeping front edge 6 sts in pattern and M1 every 3rd RS row and alt 2nd RS row (= 2 sts will be increased within 10 rows).

SIZES 12 & 14 years only

Cont in this manner, keeping front edge 6 sts in pattern and M1 every 3rd RS row (= 2 sts will be increased within 6 rows).

ALL SIZES

Cont to M1 as established until piece meas 15 (18, 21, 24)cm/6 (7, 8 $\frac{1}{4}$, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armhole

Cont to keep front M1's correct while shaping armhole.

Cast off 5 sts beg next RS row. Patt 1 row.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge next 4 rows, then every other row 3 (3, 4, 4) times.

Cont to keep front M1's correct until 30 (33, 35, 38) sts on needle. Keeping front edge patt correct, cont straight until piece meas 20 (23, 26, 29)cm/8 (9, 10 ¼, 11 ½)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - K23 (25, 26, 29) sts, slip the rem 7 (8, 9, 9) sts onto a stitch holder for neckband.

Dec 1 st at neck edge next 9 (9, 9, 10) rows, then every other row twice - 12 (14, 15, 17) sts. Cont straight until front meas 28 (32, 36, 40)cm/11 (12 $\frac{1}{2}$, 14 $\frac{1}{4}$, 15 $\frac{3}{4}$)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Cast off rem 12 (14, 15, 17) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 33 (35, 39, 41) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 3 - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 4 - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep these 4 rows 1 (2, 2, 2) times more, then work rows 1&2 (0, 0, 1&2) once.

NR (RS) - Patt 6, M1, k to end. **NR (WS)** - P28 (30, 34, 36), patt 6.

NR (RS) - Patt 6, k to end.

NR (WS) - P to last 6 sts, patt 6.

SIZES 8 & 10 years only

Cont in this manner, keeping front edge 6 sts in pattern and M1 every 3rd RS row and alt 2nd RS row (= 2 sts will be increased within 10 rows).

SIZES 12 & 14 years only

Cont in this manner, keeping front edge 6 sts in pattern and M1 every 3rd RS row (= 2 sts will be increased within 6 rows).

ALL SIZES

Cont to M1 as established until piece meas 15 (18, 21, 24)cm/6 (7, 8 $\frac{1}{4}$, 9 $\frac{1}{2}$)ins from beg, end with a RS row.

Shape Armhole

Cont to keep front M1's correct while shaping armhole.

Cast off 5 sts beg next WS row. Dec 1 st at armhole edge next 4 rows, then every other row 3 (3, 4, 4) times.

Cont to keep front M1's correct until 30 (33, 35, 38) sts on needle. Keeping front edge patt correct, cont straight until piece meas 20 (23, 26, 29)cm/8 (9, 10 ¼, 11 ½)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck

NR (RS) - Patt 6, k1 (2, 3, 3) sts, slip these just worked 7 (8, 9, 9) sts onto a stitch holder for neckband; k23 (25, 26, 29).

Dec 1 st at neck edge next 9 (9, 9, 10) rows, then every other row twice - 12 (14, 15, 17) sts. Cont straight until front meas 28 (32, 36, 40)cm/11 (12 ½, 14 ¼, 15 ¾)ins from beg, end with a RS row.

Cast off rem 12 (14, 15, 17) sts.

SLEEVES

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 43 (47, 51, 53) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *k1, p1; rep

from * to end.

Row 3 - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 4 - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep these 4 rows 1 (1, 2, 2) times more.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles. Cont in Stst and inc 1 st each end every 10 (11, 11, 11) rows until 59 (63, 69, 71) sts on needle. Cont straight until sleeve meas 34 (37, 40, 42)cm/13 ½ (14 ½, 15 ¾, 16 ½)ins from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Top

Cast off 5 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each end next 4 rows. Dec 1 st each end next 6 (7, 8, 9) RS rows.

Cast off 5 sts beg next 2 rows. Cast off 5 (6, 7, 7) sts beg next 2 rows - 9 (9, 11, 11) sts. Cast off loosely rem sts.

COMPLETE

Join fronts to back at shoulders.

NECKBAND

With RSF and 3.75mm (US 5) needles, slip the right front holder 7 (8, 9, 9) sts to needle as if they have already been worked, pick up and k24 (27, 30, 33) sts along neck edge to shoulder, k the back neck holder 31 (33, 35, 37) sts, pick up and k24 (27, 30, 33) sts down front neck to holder, k1 (2, 3, 3) sts from holder, patt rem 6 sts from holder - 93 (103, 113, 121) sts.

Keeping the front edge 6 sts correct, patt over all sts for 9 rows. Cast off loosely in patt.

BOW

With 3.75mm (US 5) needles, cast on 9 (11, 11, 13) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 3 - P1; *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 4 - K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rep these 4 rows 5 (6, 6, 7) times more.

Cast off.

Sew in ends.

Wind end of yarn several times firmly around centre of bow to form bow shape.

Sew snap fastener to right front

patt band just below beg of centre of garment when garment Set in sleeve tops, join side and neckband.

Attach bow to right front over snap fastener, ensure bow is in

is closed and that tips of bow are below the cast-off edge of the neckband.
